I have started with the basic Association Method Questions which are the foundation of language. I created handwriting worksheets with dotted lines and 3 lined paper. This is to reinforce their writing skills. I used Kaufman cards as the noun cards so that the children picked out a noun card and finished their sentences with the appropriate word preceding (a, an, the, some). We learned about past, present and future language also which we will be going over more of in the next two days. Example: how the word sit changes in its tense.
